

Palouse RV Park POLICIES

Enjoy your stay with us and please observe the following rules:

- Speed Limit: 5 MPH Maximum
- Quiet Hours: 10:00 p.m. to 9 a.m.
- Check in Time: 2:00 p.m. Checkout time 12:00 noon.
- **Reservations:** Please note the reservation sheet to check availability. Pay using either the self-check-in kiosk, or at City Hall (120 E. Main St.). Reservations are not guaranteed until payment is received. 48-hour advance notice required to cancel a site reservation for refund. **No refunds or credit for days left early, so please plan your stay accordingly.**
- **Maximum of 4 adults & up to 6 children per site.** Residents' guests using any of the facilities must pay \$2 guest fee per extra adult over first 2.
- **Pets: Limit of 2 pets per site.** Please clean up after your pet(s) with bags provided at the kiosk.
- All trailers and fifth wheels must have a tow vehicle at all times and all vehicles must be able to move under their own power in order to meet our municipal codes.
- One recreational vehicle and one tow vehicle per space. Vehicles must fit completely into space.
- Campfires in portable fire pits or designated fire pits only. Portable grills are allowed, though they must be kept at a distance from other campers.
- Tents: One tent allowed at site with paid RV. No stand-alone tent camping.
- Street parking is prohibited as it may inhibit the maneuverability of other traffic and emergency service vehicles.
- Vehicle maintenance in the RV Park is prohibited.
- Lot area must be kept clean and free of debris. Occupants are responsible to leave site in good order.
- The City of Palouse and its employees assume no liability for loss or damage to property and injury to his person or party arising out of use of its facilities or caused by others while on the premises.
- Renters and all other users of this property are liable for all property damages.
- Fireworks are not allowed in the park area.
- Guests who cannot abide by the above rules will be asked to leave the park immediately. Management reserves the right to refuse service to anyone. RV Park Rules and Policies are subject to change. All complaints shall be signed in writing and submitted at City Hall (120 E. Main Street).

Swimming Pool (seasonal): Please observe the posted and following rules:

- Children under 9 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at least 18 years or older.
- Check in with pool staff to report your site number and number of visitors using the pool.
